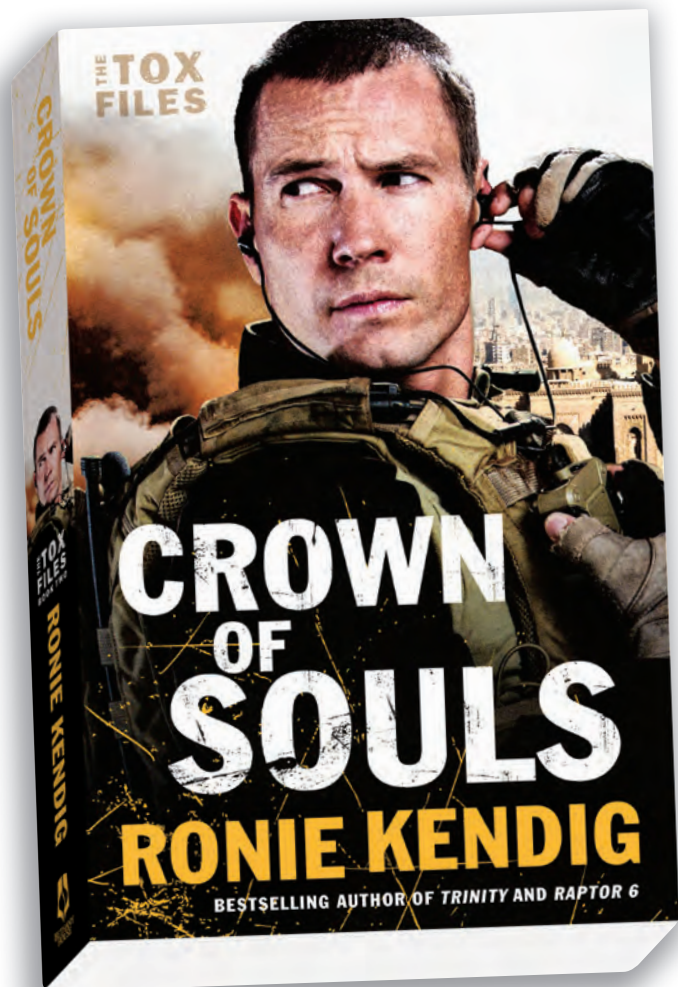

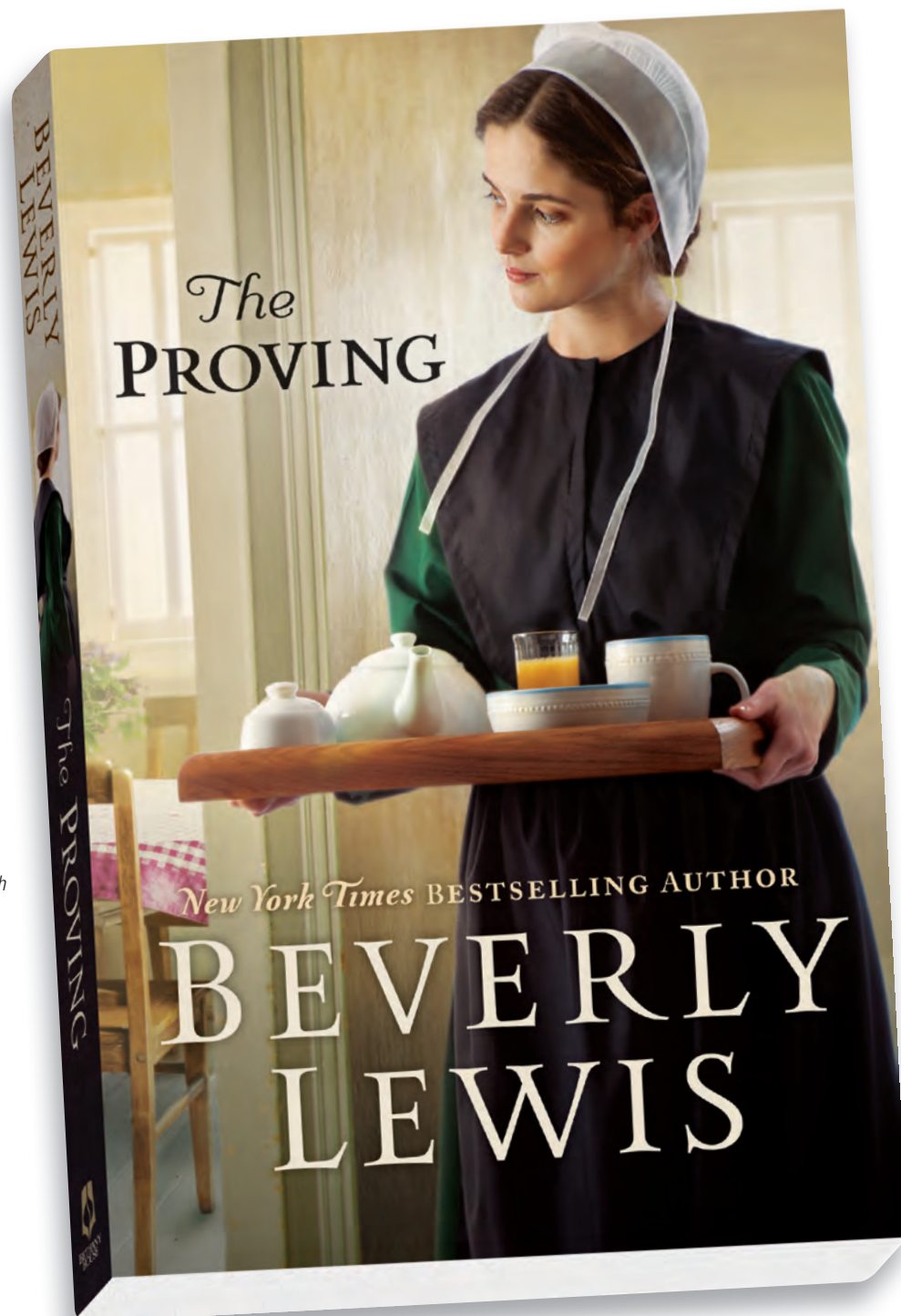

She gasped at the implication. "No. That's too much, Landon. MPC wouldn't kill one of their own employees. That's crazy."

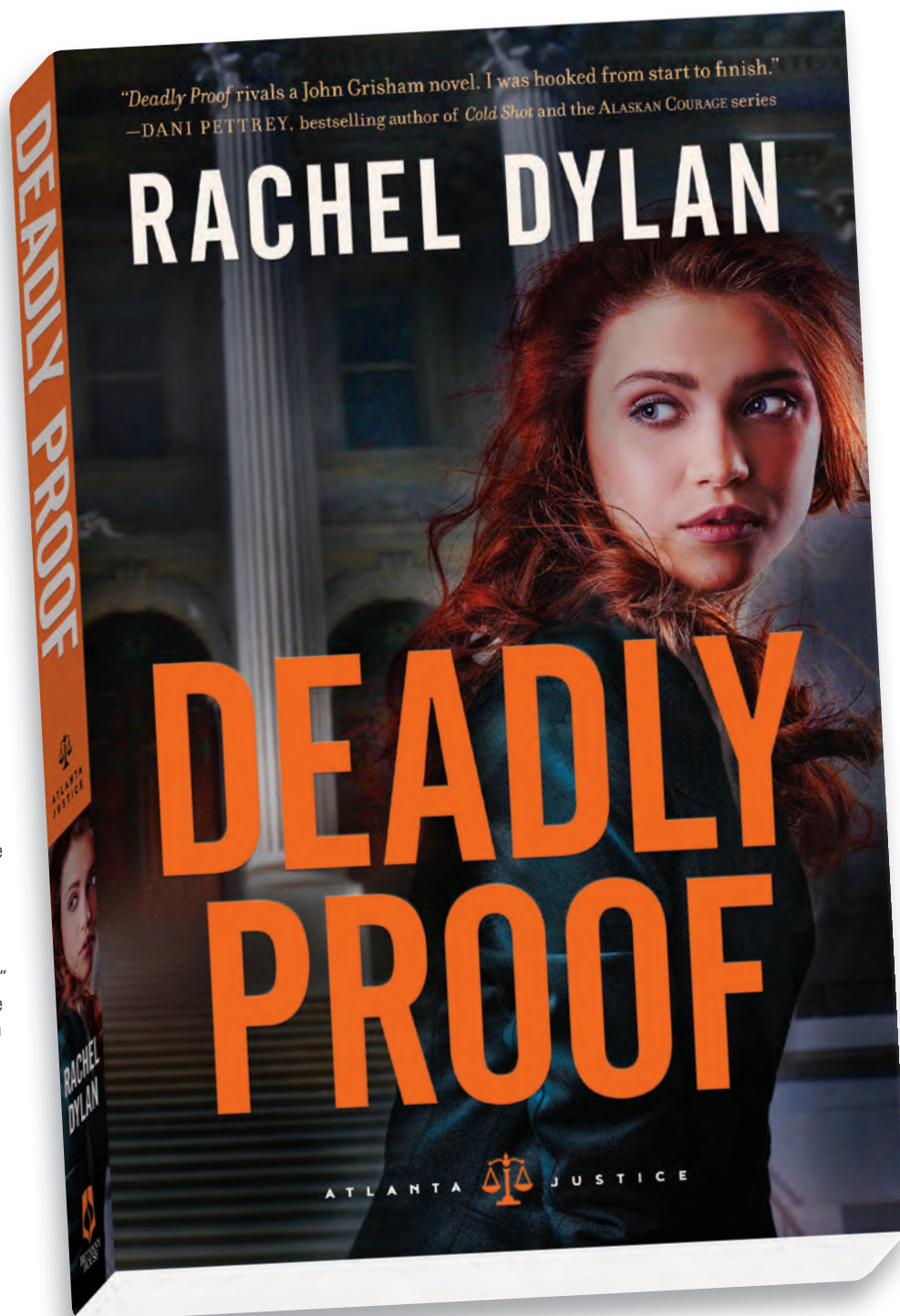
"I think maybe you're being a bit naïve about a company like MPC."
