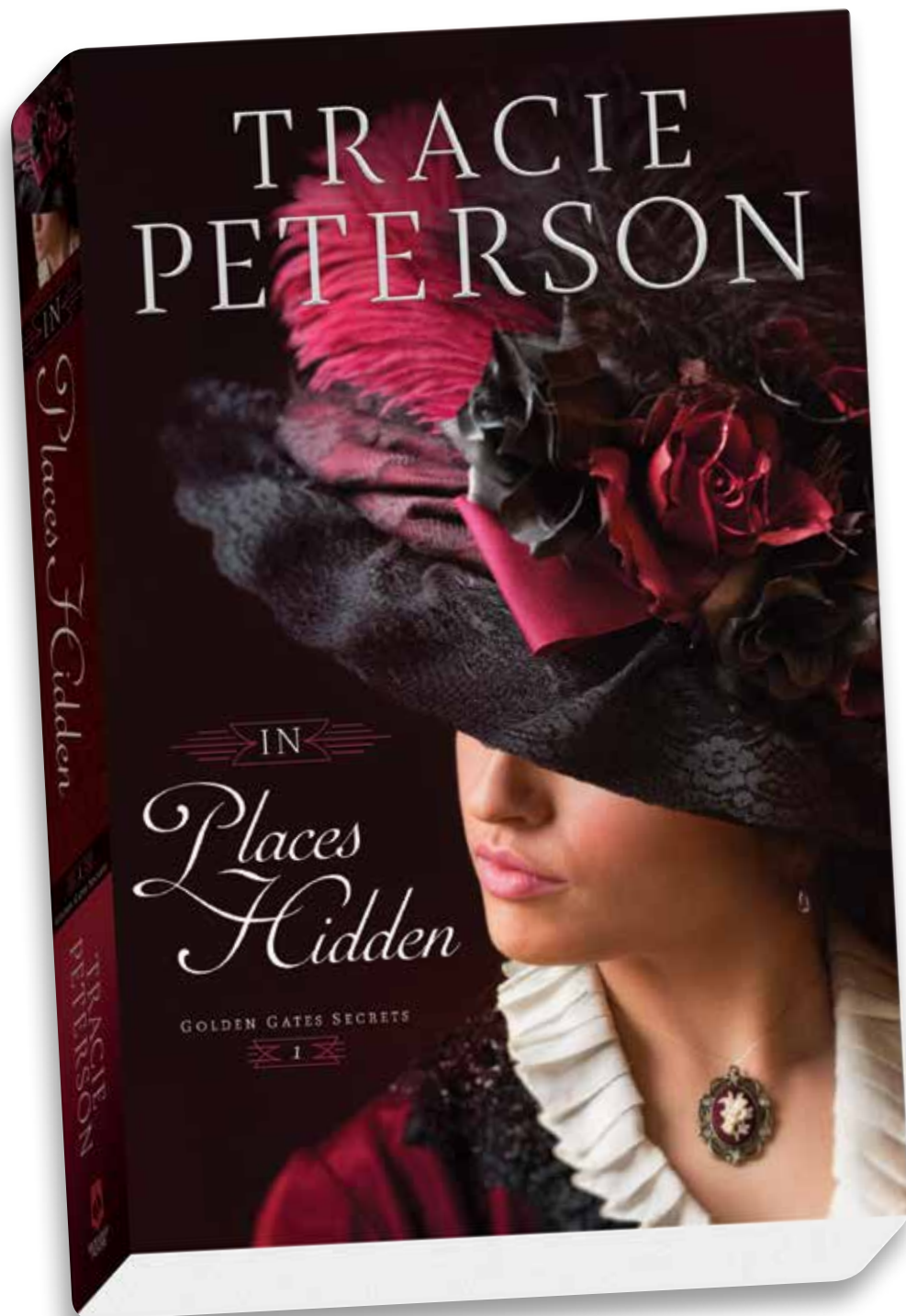
Camri jumped to her feet. "Then please, come and do so."
