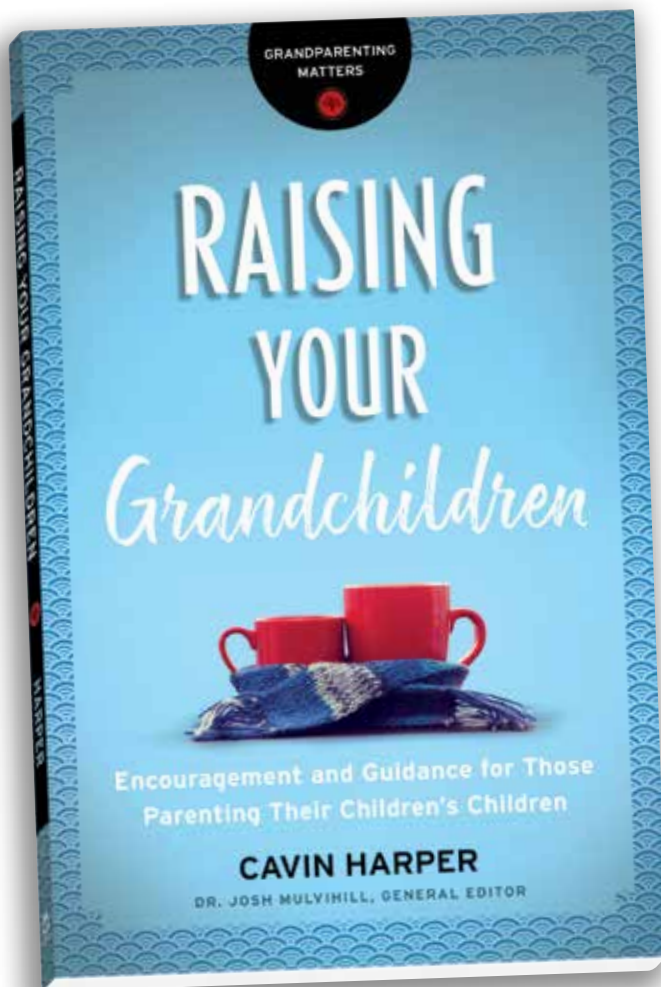

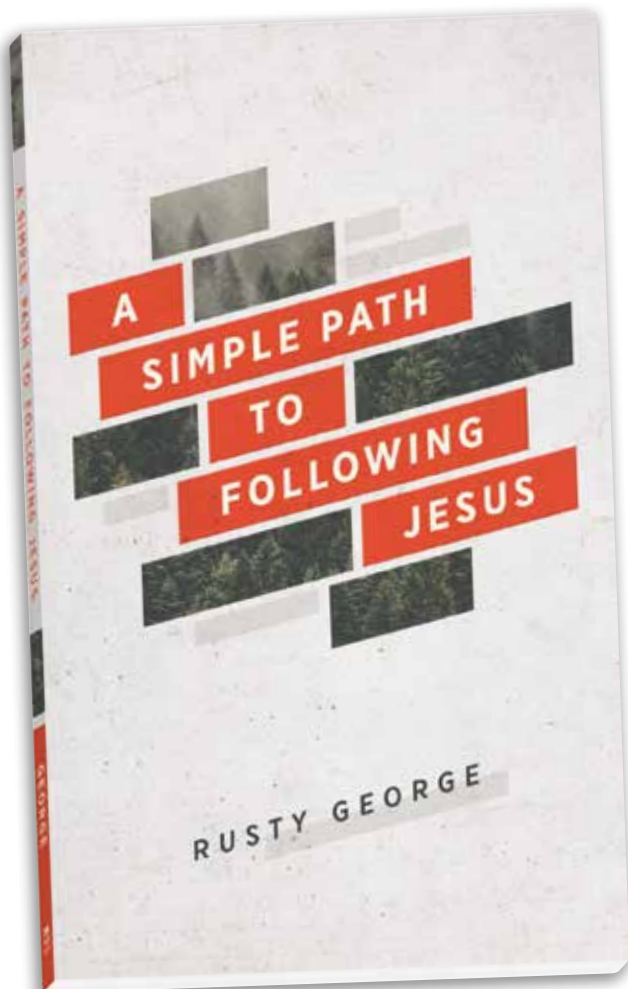

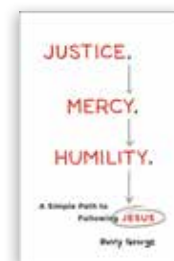

FILTER YOUR CIRCUMSTANCES THROUGH *joy*

Love and joy are most interconnected than you first may realize. The placement of these attitudes together is no coincidence. Read what Charles Spurgeon (one of the most influential ministers of the nineteenth century) says about love and joy:

Perhaps love is put first not only because it is a right royal virtue . . . but because it is a comprehensive grace and contains all the rest. All the commandments are filled in one word, and that word is love. All the fruits of the Spirit are contained in that one most . . . Godlike grace of love. See that you abound in love . . . For if you fail in the first point, how can you succeed in the second? . . . As for joy, if it be not the first product of the Spirit of God,

it is next to the last, and we may be sure that the order in which it is placed . . . is meant to be instructive. The fruit of the Spirit is love first, as a comprehensive of the rest, then joy springing out of it.

Love covers all, and out of love arises joy. This description makes a lot of sense based on what we learned about love in the first chapter. When we treasure everything in love, giving up our pride and selfishness, the freedom of those attitudes to practice unconditional love as the Bible teaches is a daily choice; joy is the spontaneous expression of our willingness to sacrifice for others. Do you know the command repeated most often in the Bible is "Rejoice"? Rejoicing means not

only having joy but also filling through the lens of joy.

While our culture is consumed with concepts such as self and enjoyment. Rather than joyful, we say we are happy through an internal source, calling back The Life-Changing, the Life-Changing Art of Loving, the life people to take possession, one by one, by action. Does this spark joy for

How we view ourselves is so intertwined with how we view God, we cannot separate the two. If one is off focus, they both are. Chances are, there are a few things in your soul that look a little blurry. You might have forgotten about them. But they're taunting you in ways you might not recognize.

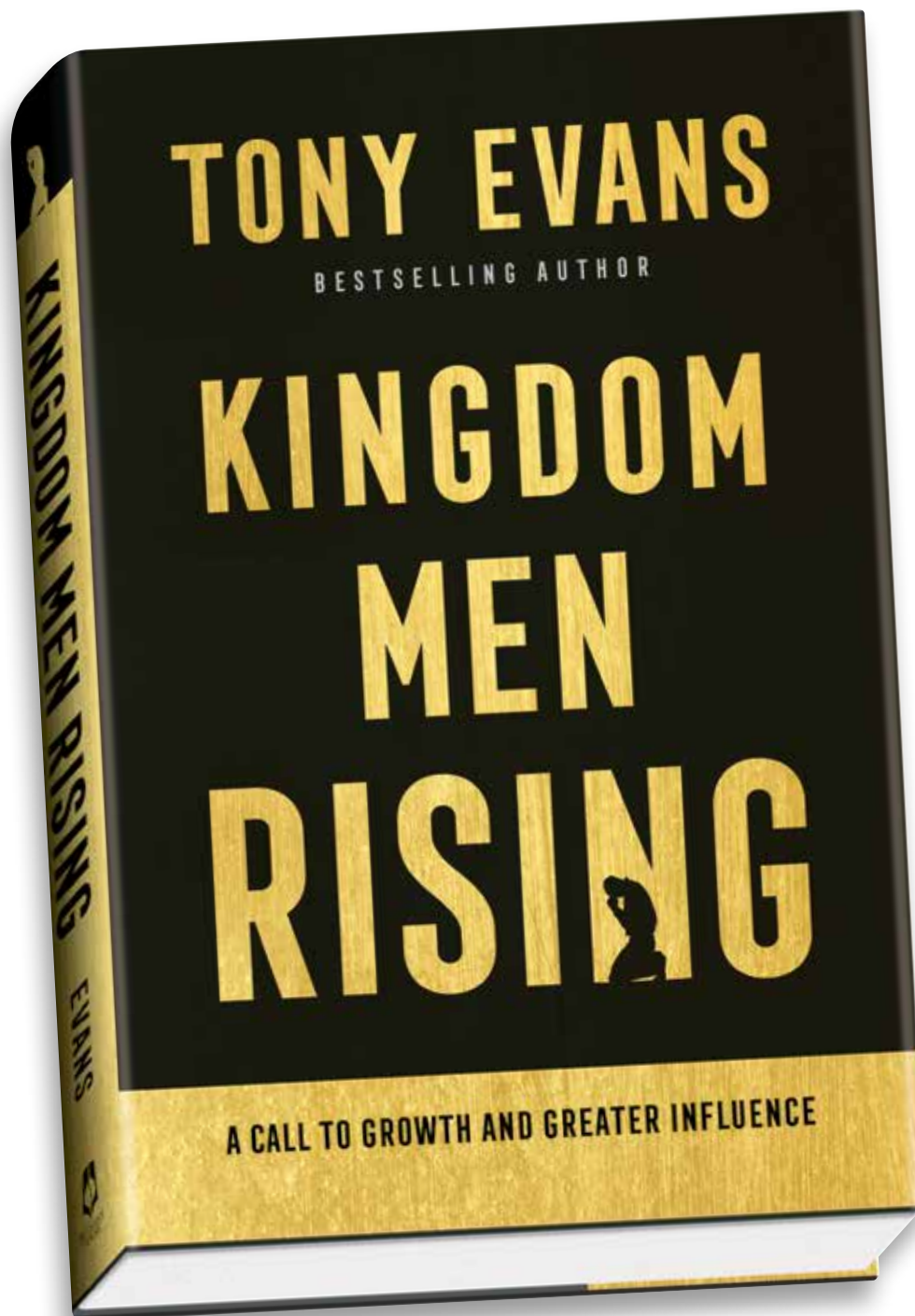

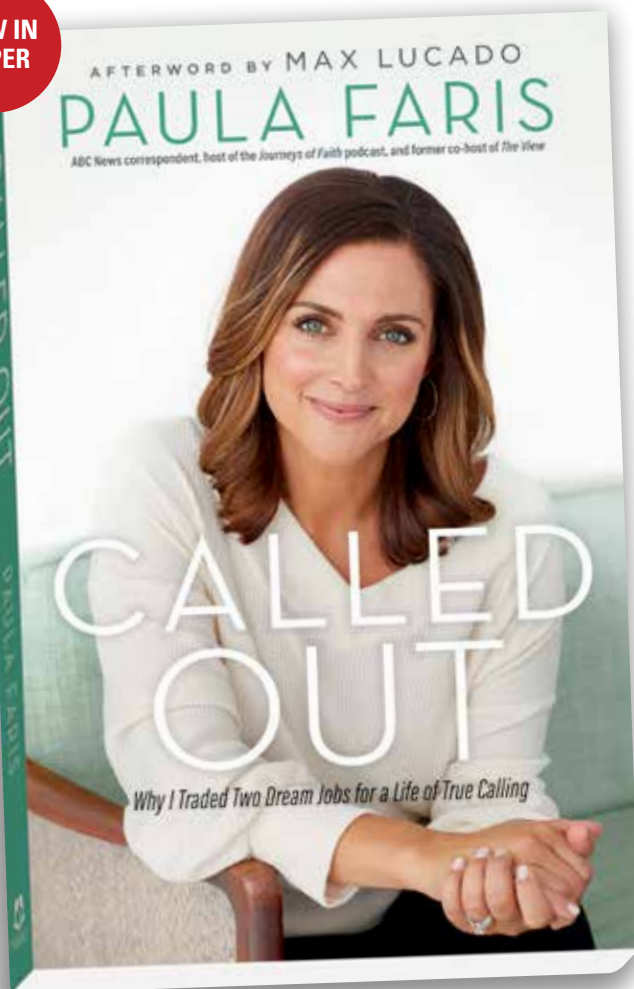
