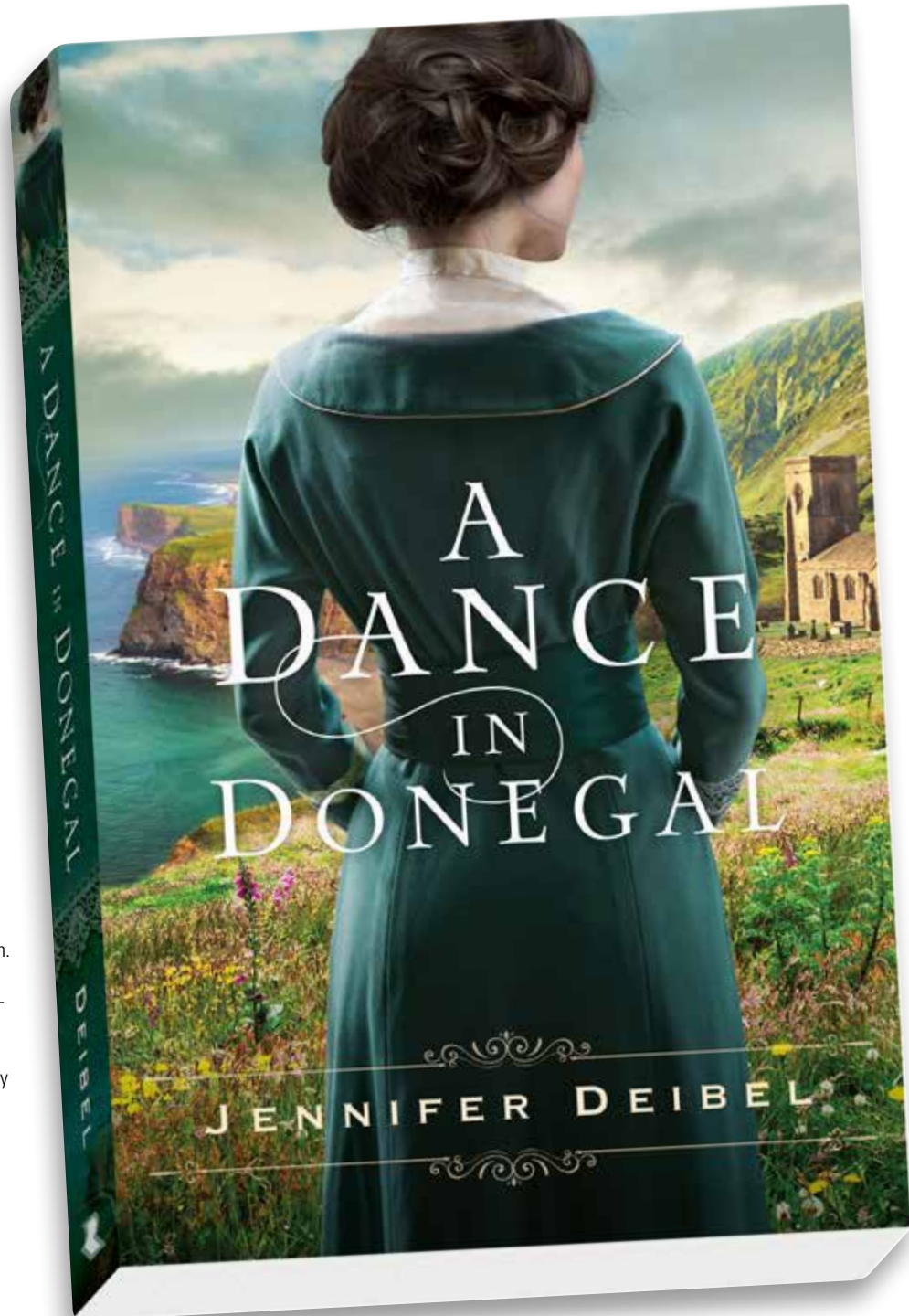
**County Donegal, Ireland

"Nope. I asked, but she said she'd wait for her order at the pick-up counter."

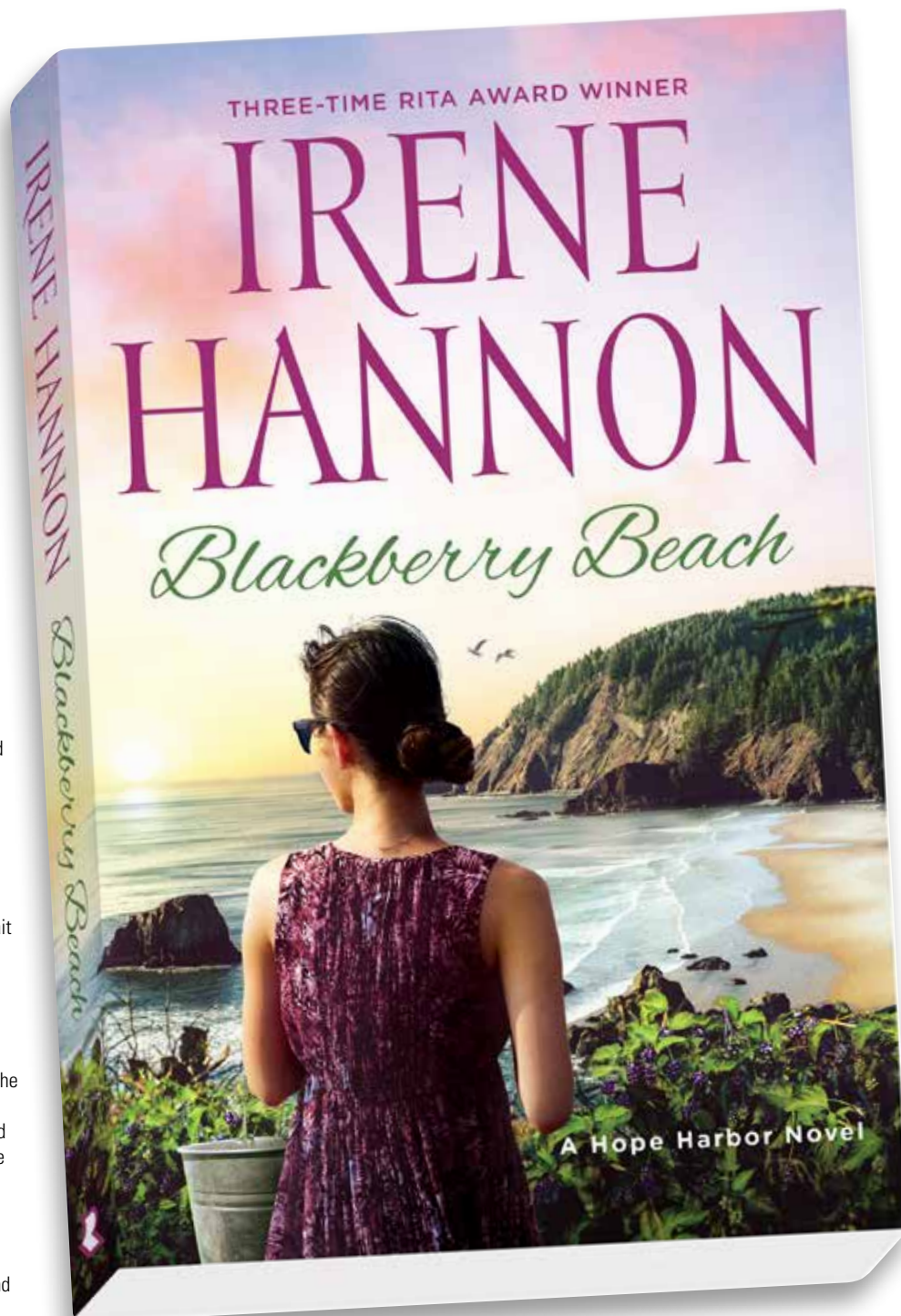
In other words, the woman wanted to remain anonymous. Also curious.
