What she wouldn't give to sit with Granddad and have one more conversation. To tell him what was going on with her. The real truth. He was the only one who could understand.

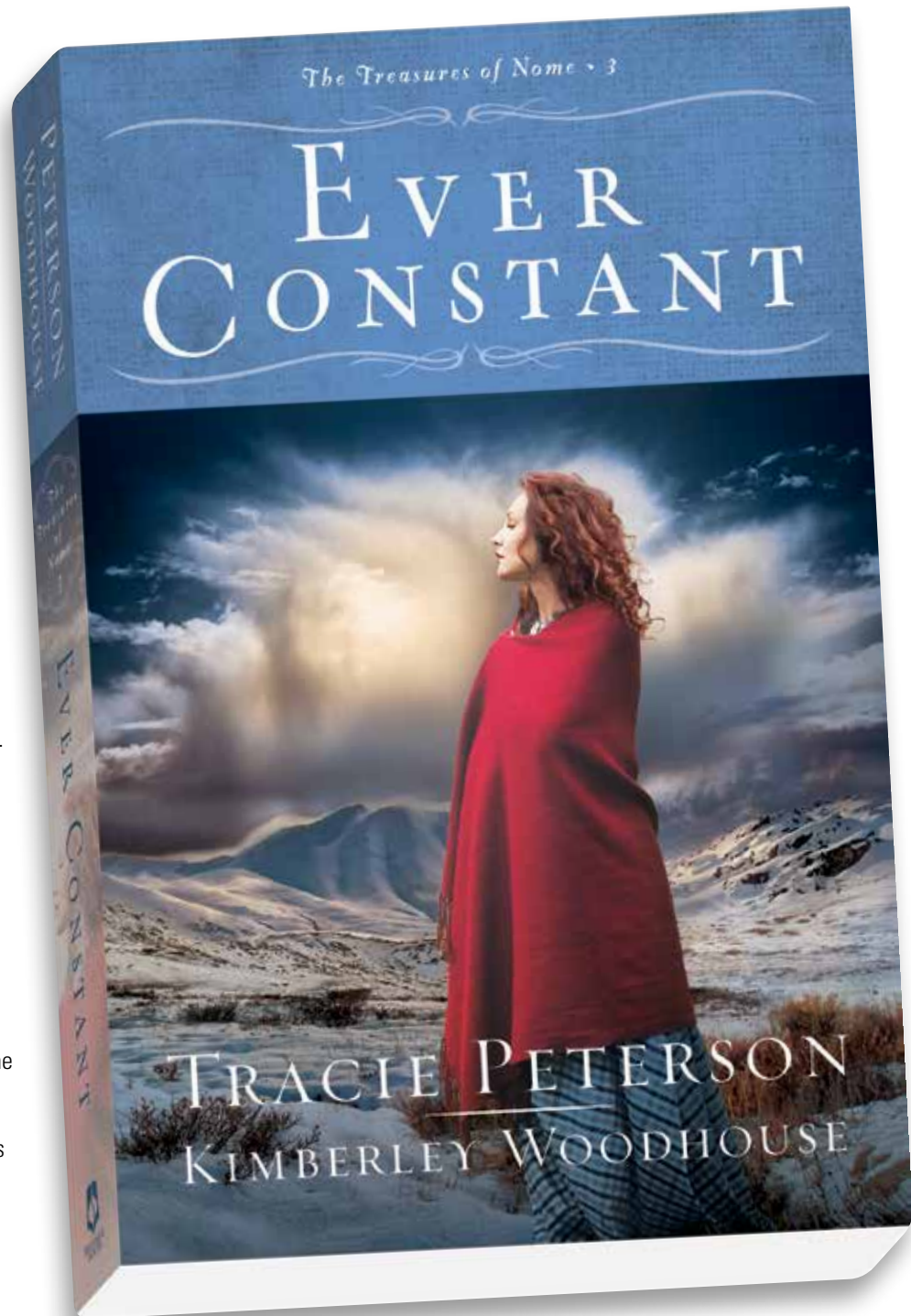

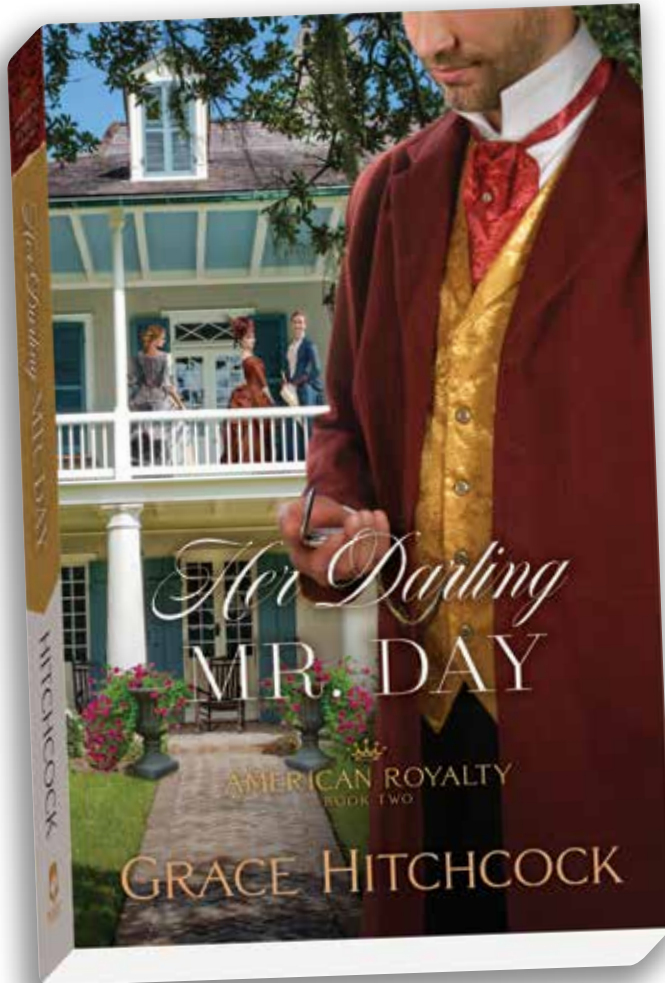

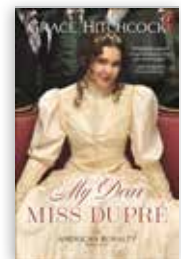

"I was happy until he sat me down to tell me there was something important that I didn't know about him."

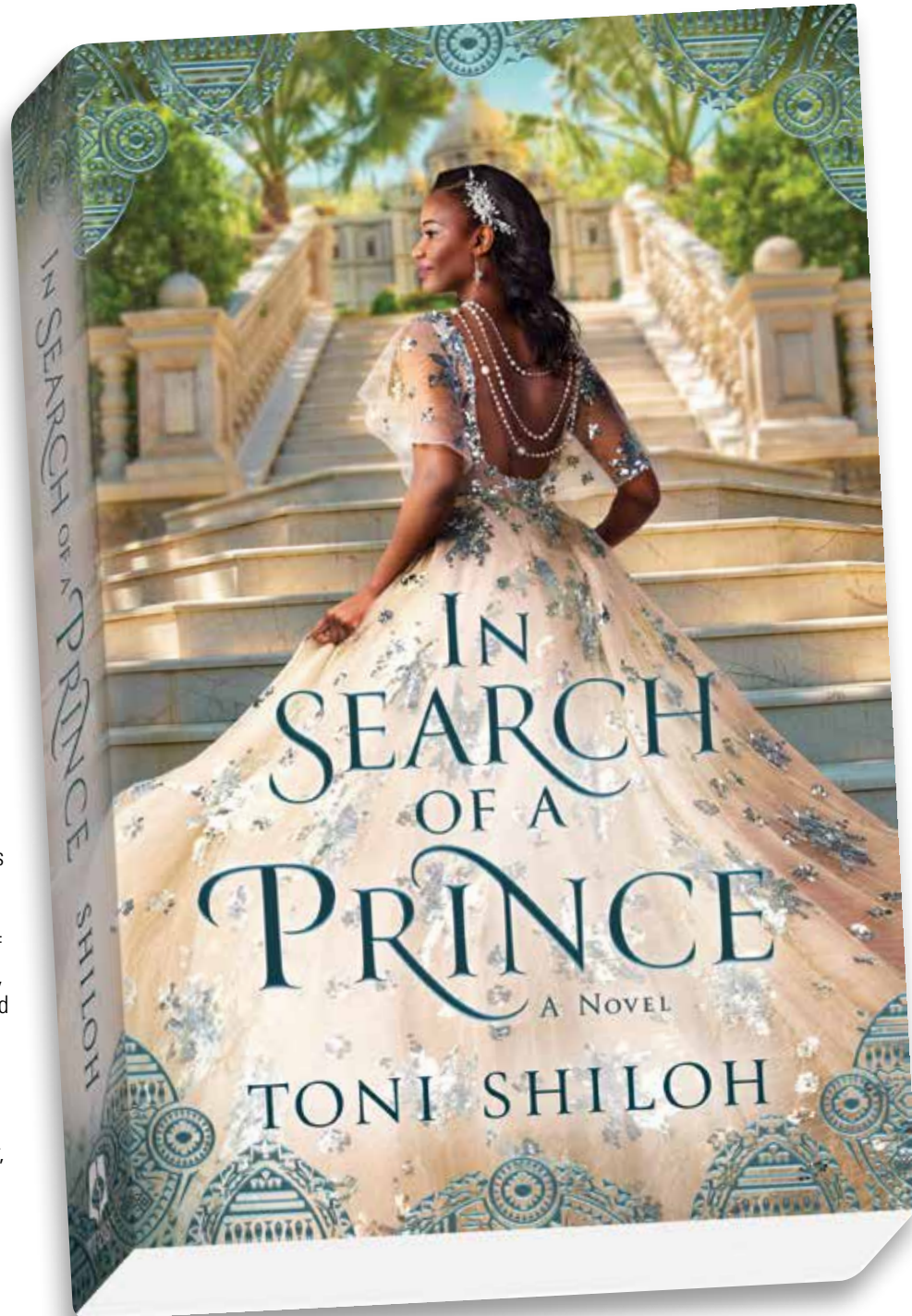
My breath hitched. What did that mean? Why hadn't I heard this part of the story before?

Which only brought out the crazies.

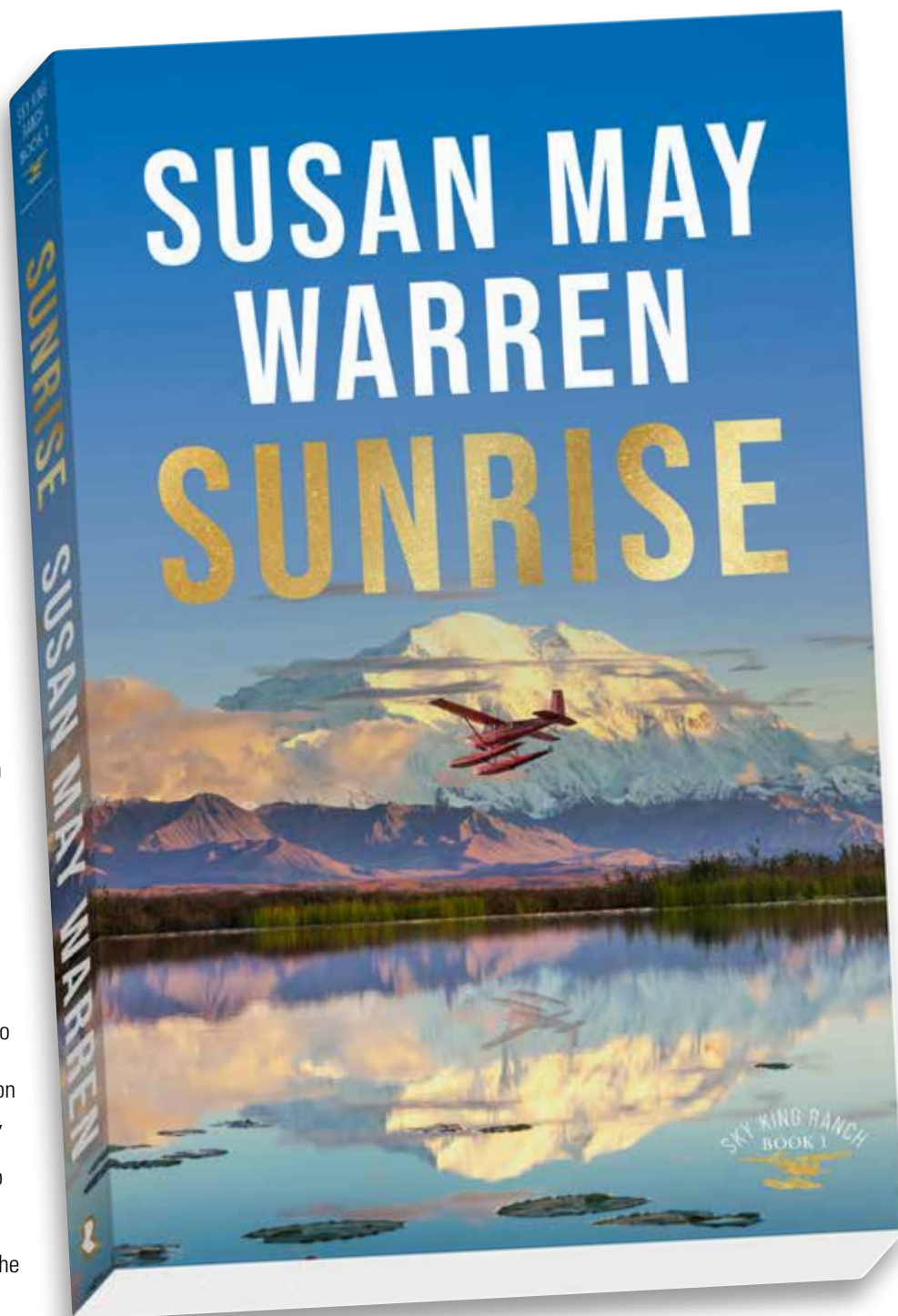
