What has you overwhelmed right now? Is there something that seems too big for you? Stress can feel like an invisible press we're caught in.

I felt it with every miscarriage. It reared its ugly head and tightened its clutches when my husband was diagnosed with cancer. I felt it with every job interview rejection. We've all felt the overwhelming "pressing and squeezing" of life's circumstances.

More than a decade of genealogical and DNA research has helped me, and all of us, make connections previously unfathomable. The fleshed-out picture clarifies the profound costs of the political constructs of race and gender in the US and on my family and all those trapped in the talons of America's hierarchies of human belonging. Several times, while researching the lives of my great-grandmothers and grandfathers I found myself weeping—literally weeping. If only the constructs of race hadn't existed, Martha might have lived, Annie might have flourished, Augustin might not have been such a monster to his children, family fracture might not be such a pathology on both sides of my family—and every woman in my matrilineal line might not have been molested or raped. How do we measure that cost? It is infinite, for it scrapes out the insides of the survivors and severely limits their capacity to flourish.

Mine is the first generation in more than four hundred years with enough distance from slavery and Jim Crow to try to assess the damage—and to demand repair. In the shadow of the four hundredth year since American slavery imposed itself on African lives—as scholars, documentarians, policymakers, and artists clarify the shape-shifting systems of control and confinement crafted to secure white supremacy on American soil—we are compelled to ask one question, lest we find ourselves in the same controlled, confined, shackled space four hundred years from now: How do we repair what race broke in the world?

Written in an accessible, conversational style that incorporates numerous stories and questions, this book exposes the weaknesses of a Western worldview through a personal engagement with Indigenous theology. Randy Woodley critiques the worldview that undergirds the North American church by dismantling assumptions regarding early North American histories and civilizations, offering a comparative analysis of worldviews, and demonstrating a decolonized approach to Christian theology.

Woodley explains that Western theology has settled for a particular view of God and has perpetuated that basic view for hundreds of years, but Indigenous theology originates from a completely different DNA. Instead of beginning with God-created humanity, it begins with God-created place. Instead of emphasizing individualism, it emphasizes a corporateness that encompasses the whole community of creation. And instead of being about the next world, it is about the tangibility of our lived experiences in this present world. The book encourages readers to reject the many problematic aspects of the Western worldview and to convert to a worldview that is closer to that of Jesus.
