

e rarely give thought to our bodies until faced with a physical challenge or crisis. With Scripture as his guide, theologian Gregg Allison presents a holistic theology of the human body from conception through eternity to equip us to address pressing contemporary issues related to our bodies, including how we express our sexuality, whether gender is inherent or constructed, the meaning of suffering, body image, end of life questions, and how to live as whole people in a fractured world.



But while I don't meet a lot of men who are confident, I do meet a lot of men who are determined. You're reading this book, so this is probably you.


